## **Materials List**

Instructor will provide specimens.

Students should bring:

Five watercolors: Veridian, Burnt Umber, Permanent Rose, French Ultramarine Blue, and Hansa Yellow Light. (Similar pigments are acceptable.)

Small spray water bottle

**Palette** 

Small cup to hold water

Bring a few small brushes\* that combine synthetic bristles with natural fibers. At least one should be #000.

Ott light (optional)

\*I use Jack Richeson 9000 Signature Series and Grumbacher Golden Edge 4620 Round.
