Supply list

Fabriano artistico HOT press paper, 300 lb (cut one sheet into 4 pieces)
round watercolor paintbrushes (sizes 00, 2, Series 7 is a good type)
watercolor paints - Ultramarine, Prussian blue, Cadmium yellow light (either Winsor Newton or Schmincke) these are suggested colors, you can bring others that are similar)
water dish
small watercolor palette
sponge
tracing paper (at least 8 ½ x 11, can be a roll)
HB pencil
one zip lock bag (gallon size)
battery operated Ott Light (there will not be plugs available)
