- 1 white gum and crepe gum
- 1 white porcelain palette
- 1 pencil 2H or 3H
- Commonly used watercolor (preference tubes)

Schmincke: May green, permanent green, emerald green, vermilion red, alizarin red, lemon yellow, Indian yellow, transparent orange, cobalt blue, ultramarine blue, lamp black, Payne's gray and opera rose.
